This led to Jesus' death.

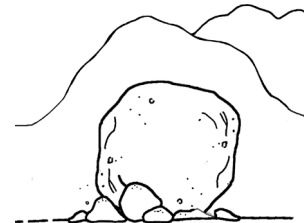


Jesus' body was placed in a tomb.
